Carol Smith Award

The fourth recipient of the Carol Smith Award is **Diane Busch**. Diane joined the Boosters in 2003. She became immediately involved as a volunteer in the Cardinal Corner Spiritwear store and was also an active volunteer with the Show Cards and Marching Band.

In 2009, Diane took on the role of Manager of the Cardinal Corner and held that role until 2012. As manager, Diane was responsible for volunteer recruitment, staffing, merchandise selection, promotions and special events. Annual sales ranged between \$25,000 and \$40,000 during this time. Additionally, she was a member of the Boosters Executive Board from 2009 – 2012.

WELCH - YERKES AWARD

The Welch-Yerkes award was established in 1995 to recognize service and commitment to the students of Colerain High School and its extracurricular programs. Mr. Welch and Mr. Yerkes were Athletic Directors from the 1940's through the mid 1970's and the award was instituted to honor their memory.

Over the years, recipients have been Booster members, coaches, fans and community partners. Selecting each year's recipient is especially difficult given the hundreds of individuals who have contributed their time and talents to make Colerain High School what it is. This year's recipient is **Bill Baumann '56**. Bill was recognized for his contributions to the students of Colerain High School and Colerain Junior High/Middle School for over 50 years. A graduate of Colerain High School, Mr. Baumann began his 35-year teaching career at Colerain Junior High in 1960. In 1962, he assumed responsibility for the operation of the clock and scoreboard for both Football and Basketball. To this day, 54 years later, he still holds this position. He

has worked at approximately 1,000 Basketball games – Junior Varsity and Varsity and 250 Football games. During this time, Colerain has had 8 Athletic Directors, 8 Football Coaches and 14 Basketball Coaches with the constant being Mr. Baumann handling the clock. Other interesting facts about Mr. Baumann • He played Basketball for Mr. Everett Welch and Baseball for 'Pop' Heizman. • Mr. Welch's and Mr Yerkes' children were students in his Geometry class. • He was a Driver's Ed instructor • He coached Junior High Football • He has been an assistant Track coach • He has been the Announcer/Scoreboard Operator for Boys and Girls Soccer for over 20 years • Even though he retired in 1995, he has continued to serve the school for 21 more years. • His 5 children are all graduates of Colerain • He was recognized at the Alumni Basketball Reunion on February 5. His passion and commitment to service are what makes Mr. Bill Baumann a most deserving recipient of this award.

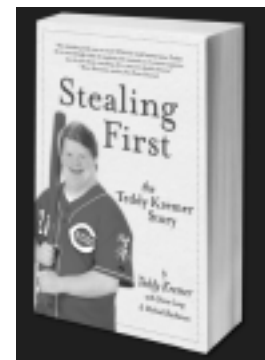

Dear Chatter: In the June, 2015, issue of the Chatter, there is an article on page 10 entitled Remember Colerain. The author, Barbara "Bobby" Foster, writes about a Facebook page going around which she saw information about shops as they used to be along Colerain Avenue near the intersection of Galbraith. I don't do Facebook so I can't look at the reminiscences, but Ms. Foster mentions a gas station on the corner of Galbraith and Colerain that she and her brother still own. I remember many visits to merchants along that strip, though I must say the visits to Dr. Test were most impressionable to a small child. I am wondering if the intersection Ms. Foster owns is the southwest corner, the far corner on the right as one heads south on Colerain Pike, as we called it then. I rarely have been back to Cincinnati since careers took us far from there so I don't know about BP, but that was the only corner with a gas station that I recall. I certainly remember that corner, as it was owned by my grandfather (Henry Fieler) when my father (Jack Fieler) was a little shaver. Grandpa passed away in 1954 when I was 5 years old so I know he had long since divested of that corner by 1954, but I remember seeing pictures of that old corner in

family scrapbooks. Grandpa had a gas pump outside, sold used cars on the lot, had a place inside to wet one's whistle, and had a pool table where my dad learned the game of eight ball, very well learned it!! Grandma and Grandpa Fieler lived on the corner of Clara Avenue and Galbraith in a house that had about a 5 car garage and workshop behind it (at least seemed that big to 5 year old me), and Grandma and Grandpa Walters lived a few houses further up Clara Avenue, about half way to the ball fields at the end of the street as it was then. I am enclosing a donation to the Chatter, and I would appreciate it if this letter could be forwarded to Ms. Foster. Perhaps if she now owns that corner, this will fill in a bit more history.
