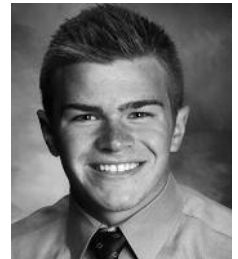

ALUMNI MAILING IMPORTANT NOTE The alumni newsletter Chatter will now be published annually. When the newsletter was first published in 1987, the cost was \$2000. The school provided help in printing and affixing the labels. The alumni association provided delivery of the newsletter to the post office. Today the newsletter is published and mailed by an outside source. The cost for the publication of one newsletter mailing is now \$8000. Bulk mail rates have increased, and there has been an increase of over 13,000 graduates from Colerain High since 1987. This is the reason for the change.

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

As another school year comes to an end, I am proud to share with you the many honors 2012-13 has brought to Colerain High School. We have successfully implemented our new Blended Learning program, which combines online curriculum with teacher support and instruction. I am proud to share with you that our 10th grade OGT scores were the highest they have ever been, earning us a performance index of 105 and another excellent rating. Our senior class has earned 4.3 million dollars in scholarships and awards, and our graduates have been accepted into over 100 universities around the country. We have 19 Summa Cum Laude students who will graduate with a GPA of 5.5 or higher. Kelly Janakiefski was named a National Merit Finalist with James McDonough and Gabriella Bishop being recognized as Commended Scholars. Also, 13 of our seniors have chosen to serve our country in the US Armed Forces, including a record 4 women.

In athletics, Colerain had another banner year. The varsity football team went to the regional championships, the boys' basketball team made the Sweet Sixteen for the third time, the girls bowling team was ranked #2 in the city and went to regionals, and the girls' softball team was district champion and competed in the Sweet Sixteen. Individually, our athletes brought honor to our school and community. In Cross Country, senior Kristen Seiler placed 6th in the state and in Wrestling, Detuan Smith was 3rd in the state in the 195 lbs. division and Tegray Scales placed 6th in the state in the 160 lbs. division. We are proud of all our athletes and their accomplishments.

In closing, Colerain High School continues to be a place where excellence is a way of life. We appreciate the support of our parents, our alumni and our community in making this possible. As we look toward the future, we are confident knowing that we have great students and great families who make us what we are. Thanks for all you do! Go Cards!

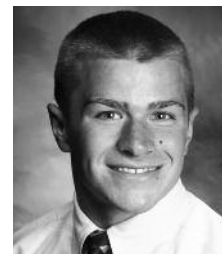

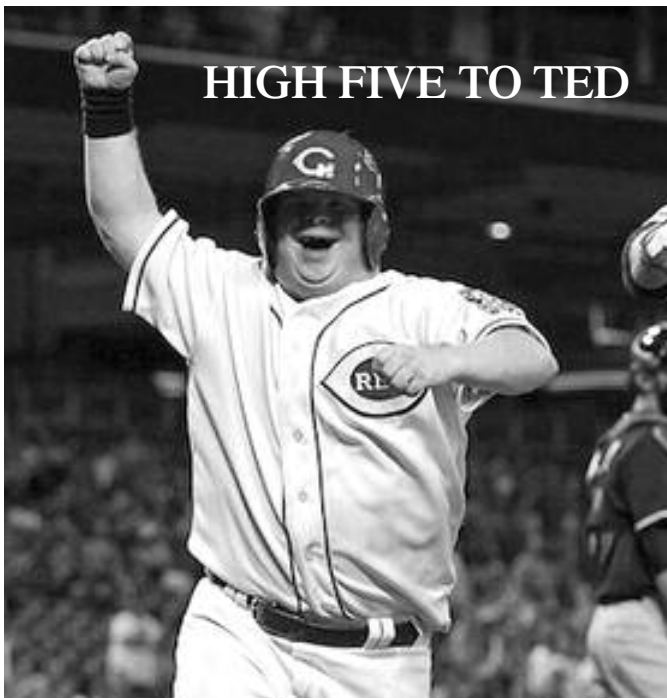

They didn't have enough players to practice the defense and offense, so they asked the eighth graders to come out. Four of us did. We would sit on the bench, go to all the games but could not play. It's been so long ago I don't remember who we played against. O.M.I. was one, Automotive was one and I think McGuffy from Oxford was one, and I know the freshman team from Hamilton was another. If I remember right, our records for both years was 3-3-1. We had one player who could run and I would say was the offense, he was the player wearing #55. That is about all I remember of the two teams. I think Paul Young and myself are the last two members of those two teams living. (Editor's note: Paul Young passed away after this note was received). Gene Taylor, Bud Schering and myself are the last members of the 1940 baseball team still living. And speaking of Bud Schering, I think he should be in the Hall of Fame. He is the only player who pitched in a state game and won it. He never pitched in a game before that. We needed a pitcher and he was it. Our regular pitcher, Gene, had a bad arm. That should be all for now.

ALUMNI - BOOSTER GOLF OUTING

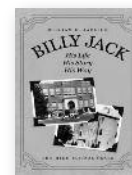

ALUMNI NIGHT 2012

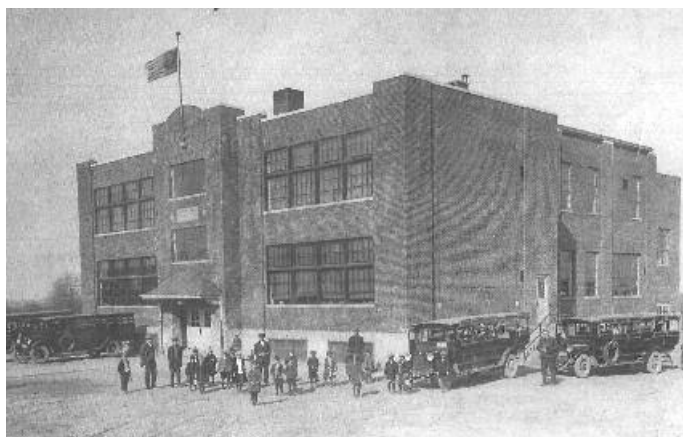

Some of the games were for blood. I think it was in 1936 we had a good eighth grade team. Seven of us made the team coached by Crawford and Sanford. We played seven or eight games during the season and ended up playing six games during the tournament with teams from the county and city. We lost the last game in overtime. What I am getting to is we won the grad tournament that year. Everybody at school thought we would have a good team for a few years with us eighth graders moving up. During the tenth grade three quit school and two moved away. Another quit during the 11th grade. That will do it for basketball. If you want to use part of this or not any of it as I had twelve great years at Colerain. I wish everyone could have the years we did. No baseball team has gone to State yet as we did in 1940.
