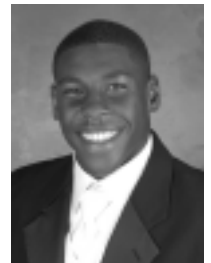

Greetings,

My first year as principal at Colerain High School was a huge success! It is my pleasure to thank the staff, students, and wonderful community for welcoming and supporting me along this journey. Colerain High School's rich tradition of excellence continues. In addition to our various athletic and creative and performing art achievements, this year we had a record breaking number of students who received the distinction of Summa Cum Laude, the highest academic honor. 30 students in the class of 2015 had a grade point average of at least a 5.5 on a weighted scale. In addition, this year's graduating class of 450 students earned over \$7.4 million in academic and athletic scholarships.

This year we transitioned to the state's new assessment model, PARCC (Partnership of Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) and AIR (American Institutes for Research). This new online assessment model provides performance based and end of year tests for English, Math, Science, and Social Studies. As we await the results of these assessments, we are proud to again report that our sophomores performed very well on the outgoing state assessment, the OGT (Ohio Graduation Test). Preliminary results indicate that we met all of the state targets.

Next year, we look forward to another exciting year. This summer, I plan to review my first year and make positive changes for the years to come.

2004 FOOTBALL STATE CHAMPION REUNION

During halftime of the Colerain – Fairfield football game, the 2004 State Championship team was honored. It has been ten years since the team completed an undefeated season by defeating Canton McKinley 50 – 10 to win the Division I championship. Colerain averaged 46.3 points per game and yielded only 6.5 points per game. During the playoffs the Cardinals outscored their opponents 191 to 22. Linebacker Andre Revels who works for a computer company in San Francisco said it seems like only yesterday but in fact it was ten years ago. He feels blessed for the journey he started at Colerain with his "band of brothers".

DISTINGUISHED GRADUATE

This year's Distinguished Graduate was **Bill Lohrer**, Class of 1957.

While at Colerain Bill was active in Pep Club, Hi Y, Thespians and was sports editor of the school paper, the Quill. He graduated from Ohio University in 1961 with a degree in Journalism. WELCH - YERKES AWARD

The Welch – Yerkes award was established in 1995 to recognize service and commitment to the students of Colerain High School and its extracurricular programs. Mr. Welch and Mr. Yerkes were Athletic Directors from the 1940's through the mid 1970's and the award was instituted to honor their memory.

Over the years, recipients have been Booster members, coaches, fans and community partners. Selecting each year's recipient is especially difficult given the hundreds of individuals who have contributed their time and talents to make Colerain High School what it is.

This year's recipient, **David Smith**, is in his thirteenth year as Director of Bands at Colerain High School. His responsibilities include Wind Symphony, Concert Bands, Jazz Band, and Cardinal Marching Band and oversees all extracurricular winter activities. The bands at Colerain have performed three times at the Walt Disney World Resorts, Gatlinburg Tennessee and twice in New York City winning the National High School Jazz Festival in 2005. The Cardinal Marching Band has also been an OMEA State Finalist every year it has participated. David was named Colerain High School Teacher of the Year in 2007-08. He resides in Hebron, Kentucky, with his wife, Melody, and daughter, Madison.

COLERAIN BAND

Congratulations to the Cardinal Marching Band who has had a tremendous year. The band won Grand Champion at the Westerville North Marching Invitational. The band also won Reserve Grand Champion at Miamisburg, Goshen, and Harrison. The band won best music 4 times, best visual 4 times, best overall effect 4 times, best guard 4 times, best percussion 4 times, and received a **PERFECT SCORE AT THE STATE MARCHING BAND CHAMPIONSHIPS**. The Winter Guard won 1st place 5 times, won the Silver Medal at Championships, was WGI Regional Finalist, WGI World Championship Semi-Finalist for the 4th year in a row and ended the season ranked 27th in the world out of over 300 guards. Indoor Percussion was WGI Regional Finalist, WGI World Championship Semi-Finalist for the first time in school history, and ended the season ranked 21st in the world out of over 300 drumlines. Out of over 300 high schools in the world, only 8 high schools had both their guard and percussion make World Championships Semi-Finals, and one of those 8 was your very own Colerain High School Band Program.
