Two former Colerain students were selected as Distinguished Graduates. The first was **Hamilton County Commissioner Todd Portune** from the Class of 1976. Todd was an excellent runner in high school. He was All League and All City as a member of Colerain's Track and Cross-Country Teams. Todd was active in student council, band, was President of C Club, and was chosen as a National Merit Scholar.

Todd graduated from Oberlin College in 1980 with a Degree in Government. During his four years at Oberlin Todd ran varsity track and was a kicker for the football team. Todd was inducted into the Oberlin Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998. He received his Law Degree from the University of Cincinnati in 1983. Todd is a Trial Attorney and partner in the law firm of Cohen, Kite, and Stanford. He has served on the Cincinnati Human Relations Commission and was a member of Cincinnati City Council from 1993-2000. In 2001 he won election to his present job as Hamilton County Commissioner. Todd and his wife Angie have twins Ellyse and Ethan, and daughter Emma and reside in Westwood.

Our next Distinguished Graduate was Judge Ted Winkler from the Class of 1979. Ted was an outstanding athlete at Colerain. He played outside linebacker on the football team and was starting center in basketball. The 1979 Cardinal Football team won the Suburban League Championship. In Memory of **Jane Sprunger**, longtime English teacher at CHS. A recent obituary told of the passing of Jane Sprunger, Longtime English teacher at CHS. There is so much more to the story than the simple fact of her death; there is the story of her inspiration, her dedication, and her love of teaching which blessed so many CHS students. This is my part of the story. As a junior, I asked to be placed in her honors English class. Unlike other students, who were selected for the class, I had to ask for the course because I was new to the school district and so lacked a recognized history of high grades in English. Miss Sprunger was kind enough to take a chance on me. Summer came and with it, the summer reading list, providing the adage "be careful what you ask for". There was Franz Kafka's "The Trial", the title of which pretty much summed up my "Summer of Reading". William Faulkner's "As I Lay Dying" became "as I Lay Reading". There was a Shakespeare play, I forget which one, which turned out to be the easiest of the lot. Worst, or should I say "most challenging" was Dante's "Inferno" which was just as incomprehensible in Italian as in English as far as I was concerned; except that the reading list did seem to correspond to one of the rings of Hell described therein. The list was not given to us to "skim at your leisure" but rather we were told "be ready for a test the first day of school". Not even college was that demanding. I showed my readiness for college by saving all the books until the last few weeks of August, finishing the Cliff's Notes for the last book while seated at a Red's game the night before the first day of school. Mss Sprunger was not kidding about the test – there were, in fact, two days of tests. I forget how I did on them, but they were definitely a "Trial by Inferno". The class itself was a delight. Most of us had already been introduced to, and were pretty good at, deciphering and dissection prose and poetry, and we had some lively discussions. Miss Sprunger always knew how to draw out the best answers, how to direct the flow of comments, how to inspire enthusiasm for the literature. She was always encouraging and supportive, challenging and insightful. She expected us to give our best, and we did. I ended up earning a 5.0 (as good as it gets) on the Advanced Placement exam, for which her course had qualified and prepared me. I think she did not regret giving me that chance to take Honors English. I became an English major at U.C., was an honors student there as well, mot my MA in English Literature (having entirely avoided all German existentialist authors), and went on to U.C. Law School to earn my JD. There were many reaches I could thank for all the things I've accomplished, all the lessons I've learned, and all the inspiration I have had, but she stands out as one of the best, the kindest, and the most supportive. 


