I have to react to the mention of Les "Pop" Heizman passing. I played football under "Pop" and Jim Driscoll ('57-'59). I have some memories of "Pop" I'd like to share. Many times we finished practice by having 50-yard dashes and the first two went in to the showers as the rest stayed and continued to run. Some of the players joked and moaned to "Pop" about all the running. He took, and gave, hassling back and forth with a smile. One time someone said, "Come on Pop you run with us if it's so easy." His eyes twinkled and coach Driscoll smiled and looked away a Pop said, "why, do you want me to race you guys?" Being typical 17 year olds we all scoffed and said, "Yeah!" He calmly stood on the goal line and said, "OK, line up any of you." This was the lineman, but we backfielders started running over thinking we could certainly put some speed on him. Now almost every man on the varsity lined the full goal line. Pop raised his hand and said, "Wait, this isn't fair." As

we hooted and laughed he silenced us as he walked over and picked up a metal bucket with stuff in it. He also picked up a couple helmets with his other arm. He said, "Okay, now it's even." We couldn't believe it. As we crossed the 40-yard line, Pop had 5-8 yards on all of us as he turned around backwards over the 50-yard line (finish). As we expressed our astonishment he said, "Want to try again, backwards?" No one wanted any part of it. We stopped complaining. I told a friend of mine, Norb Shibinski, who played football with Les at the University of Cincinnati. He said Pop was the fastest lineman at U.C. And, he added, he was even faster than everyone else in a backwards race. Sometimes Pop would stand in a middle linebacker spot straight-legged with his arms crossed watching his defense take on the first offense at practice. Once, as halfback contact, I got the ball on a quick-opener/dive play. I charged into the line expecting hard contact. I was running (I thought) at full speed leaning forward and charging to run over the expected defender. I ran into Pop untouched. I bounced back like I had hit a tree. He gave a surprised "Uhn" as I hit him but didn't even lose his balance of step back. I staggered, slipped off and was immediately tackled. He was like an immovable fireplug. WOW! After Pop retired, I saw him a Credit Union meeting. I asked him the usual question, "What are you going to do now that you're retired?" He responded, "I thought I'd raise turkeys. I've got a lot of experience there." As I continued to ask about it he chuckled about a certain breed of turkey, but I could see I was missing something. It wasn't till on the way home I realized his humor of referring to we students as turkeys. Good one, POP! You got us again. We'll all miss you. **Nelson Smith '59** Mason, OH

Gene brought me a score book that had baseball games starting in 1934 through 1939. There are some games missing and also the softball games in 1938. In the book was a newspaper picture of the 1923 soccer team that went undefeated. I have enclosed a copy of that picture. I don't know what Gene told you about himself, so here is a couple of things. He never struck out less than 11 batters and most of the time it was 14 or more. One game he had 18. He also had 3 no hitters. We won everything in 1939 and was eligible to go to State but the school didn't have the money to send us. When we went to State in 1940 Gene had a sore arm so we pitched the shortstop Bud Siering. He never pitched a game before. In the ninth he got into trouble after two outs the got two men on base. The score was 4-3. Gene came in and I signaled a fast ball he shook off, then a curve he shook off so I signaled a knuckle ball. He threw it and If Don Aston at third wouldn't caught it in self defense it would have killed him, it was a rocket. Don pitched the final and got bombed. Gene didn't pitch his final year as he signed with the Reds. That should do it for now.

All animals are in small concrete enclosures and display the classic signs of zoo stress of constant pacing. I have formed a group called Okinawa

Zoo Action Project that is dedicated to demanding urgent change and exposing this place to the world for the cruelty it inflicts on its animals. One animal we have particularly rallied around is the North American Timber Wolf. Her name is Kei and she approx. 16 years old. Loosely based on the movie, Free Willy, we have begun a grass roots movement of people around the world calling for her release to a better place so that she may end her final year or two in a tranquil environment without kids barking at her or throwing food at her. Initially zoo officials said that if we found a place willing to accept her they would let her go. Well, we did find a wolf sanctuary in Colorado that agreed to accept her but then the zoo reneged on their word. We are now embattled with them in trying to gain her release. If you would like to see a picture of her or read about some of our efforts please take a look at okinawazap.com. There you can e-mail me also and ask how you can get involved in calling for her release to a retirement with dignity. International pressure is something that moves Japanese to reconsider their actions. As you may be aware of, Japanese are very sensitive to their image and how others view them. I hope that my school of Colerain will show the world that it is not a school where the graduates are insular like its geographic location, and indeed can reach out with sympathy and empathy to assist in affecting change by righting a wrong.
