1967 COLERAIN GRAD FIRST LADY OF HONDURAS

Tegucigalpa, Honduras – Mary Flake, the 1967 Colerain High School graduate so shy she dreaded being called upon in class, now summons the strength as first lady of Honduras to help a nation rebuild. "My classmates would find this so unbelievable – I find it unbelievable", Mary Flake Flores, the wife of Honduran President Carlos Flores Facusse, said during a meeting this week with American reporters and executives of Cincinnati-based Chiquita Brands International. "I was absolutely the shyest student in the whole class.

before it. Chiquita already has assumed a leadership role in providing free ocean transport for donated food, clothing and other emergency supplies to Honduras. And Mrs. Flores said she has been touched that so many in Cincinnati have responded generously to the hurricane relief effort. "It makes me feel that,

after so long, I still have many friends there”, she said. Mrs. Flores said she believes that many of Honduras’ six million residents – half of who are under 18 – are still in shock and do not fully comprehend “the dimension of the tragedy”. “This is going to be a long-term effort to re-

establish the country. Some people are very despondent. We don’t want them to leave the country and look for jobs elsewhere. We need to give our economy a jumpstart!” Recalling her days at Colerain, Mrs. Flores said that she took part in many home economics and 4-H

projects – activities that contributed to the school’s PTA awarding her its college scholarship. “So I think they made a good selection,” she said laughing. You never know what’s going to happen to you.

History of Colerain High

Colerain Centralized Township School opened in September 1924. In the April 26th, 1924 Hamilton Journal Newspaper there was an entire page given to the history of the many one and two room schools that had served the area. The following article is about the construction of the original school building at Springdale and Poole Rds in 1924. This building had all twelve grades and graduated the first graduating *Class of 1925*. In future editions we hope to also write the histories of Peach Grove, Cliptown, Groesbeck, Blue Rock, Dry Ridge, and Old Round Top schools. **Editors note: The actual sentences and grammar are exactly as it appeared in the Hamilton Journal of April 26th, 1924.**

Colerain Township Centralized School

George W. Barkman, architect, of Hamilton, Ohio designed the building. Mr. Barkman specializes in village and rural schools and is not only an authority on construction, but understands school systems, publicity, legal procedures, bond issues. Etc. The building as it now stands is the result of the hearty cooperation of the Board of Education with the architect. The Board of Education gave much of their valuable time for consultation and advice. George K. Foster, the clerk, devoted a great deal of his time in the details in connection with the local issue, sale of bonds, selection of site, etc. Professor Rennel, county superintendent of schools and Professor Struble of the high school, were also hard workers in planning the requirements. The architect expressed himself in an interview as feeling greatly obliged to the three gentlemen above mentioned for the assistance which they gave him on the preliminary work. The 1st floor of the school contains six classrooms; the 2nd floor, three classrooms and the basement, three classrooms for domestic science, manual training, agriculture, also rooms for mothers’ club and the Board of Education. The auditorium seating 500 is located on the 2nd floor. The library is on the mezzanine floor near the main stairway. The building is wired for electric lights and is equipped for modern plumbing. The building is planned not only for school purpose but it also furnishes a community center for social and athletic affairs. The ground contains twelve areas.

The Board of Education, aiming to be fair in the community and not wishing to be accused of any partiality in selecting the site, appointed a committee of ten representative citizens of the township to select a site. The building is heated by low pressure steam and has an automatic system of ventilation. The building is of fireproof construction. Butler Bros. Glendale, Ohio, were the general contractors. Roy Ogg, Trenton, Ohio, heating and ventilating and the Walker Contracting company handled the electric wiring and the plumbing contracts. The special feature in the auditorium is that the rostrum has two dressing rooms which can be reached without entering the main auditorium. This is especially desirable when giving class plays and general entertainments. This auditorium and social rooms in the basement can be reached without entering the corridors of the school proper. This eliminates confusion and any annoyance in the school; in fact, meetings can be held in the auditorium by outsider organizations while the school is in session. The offices, two in number, are close to the main entrance and immediately attract the attention of visitors upon entering the building. While the building is of neat appearance, the Board of Education has not wasted any money for special ornamentation preferring to spend the township’s money for adequate rooms and sanitary equipment and safe construction. The approximate cost of the building, exclusive of equipment, but including the architect’s fee and the size is \$93,000.00. There has been some little criticism about the position in which the building has been placed, but this was due to the rolling nature of the ground. When the final grading is completed, making a cut in the road and the front yard of almost three feet, the site will present a much more pleasing appearance.

Dear Colerain Alumni Association: I want you to know that I enjoy reading the Colerain CHATTER. I am writing this note however to let you know that my grandson, Keith Toth ('92), died on August 29, 1998. He had cancer of the spinal cord and the tumor became very aggressive after two surgeries early on in 1998. He had this cancer as a child and had gone through two operations on his spine before he was 10 years old, as well as having 35 radiation treatments after the 2nd operation. The cancer went into remission for 13 years which gave him time to go through school and graduate. During his high school years he wanted to play sports but the cancer had left him slightly disabled and he always felt "different" than his classmates. He did however help me on Friday nights at the football games as manager, batboy, and other duties. He loved Colerain High School.
