The Welch – Yerkes award was established in 1995 to recognize service and commitment to the students of Colerain High School and its extracurricular programs. Mr. Welch and Mr. Yerkes were Athletic Directors from the 1940's through the mid–1970s and the award was instituted to honor their memory.

Over the years, recipients have been Booster members, coaches, fans, and community partners. Selecting each year's recipient is especially difficult given the hundreds of individuals who have contributed their time and talents to make Colerain High School what it is.

This year's recipient, Steve Tapogna, has been a coach at Colerain High School since 1980 when he became the Boys Soccer Coach. Steve has coached 47 seasons covering 4 sports as the Varsity head coach. No coach in the history of Colerain has coached this many seasons!

LEE R. SUMAN, the teacher who had the greatest positive impact on my life, grades 5-12, passed away on Saturday, November 2. He not only was a great teacher, but he was also a well respected friend to all of his students. At various times during my adult life I have had the pleasure of playing music with him (Lee on percussion and me on French horn) in various ensembles. Then, upon my 2nd retirement as a high school administrator in 2010, I joined the New Horizons Band of Cincinnati where Lee was the head conductor and his wife, Shirley, was a percussionist. What a privilege it was to again play under Lee Suman's baton. Lee's health challenges were increasingly evident those next three years leading to his stepping down as head conductor this last Spring of 2013. At his last concert he was extremely weak, but with a smile on his face he approached the front of the band and conducted "The Stars and Stripes Forever." As my mentor conducted, he winked at me. Tears ran down my face

because I realized that after conducting that piece of music hundreds of times, that this time would be his last time. Lee was given a standing ovation and was honored with the distinction of being named as Conductor Emeritus of the New Horizons Band, Cincinnati. During his lifetime, Lee instilled a love of music in the lives of thousands. I will always appreciate his friendship and the positive impact that he had on my life. In the future, playing "The Stars and Stripes Forever" will always hold special memories for me. SENIOR CITIZEN BRUNCH


