**SHOW CARDS** is a competitive singing/dancing group from CHS. The group was originally formed as a small choral group in 1998. The following year they evolved into a singing and dancing group of male and female students. Members are selected through audition. Many are National Merit Scholarship candidates, varsity sport athletes, honor students, cheerleaders, band members, or involved in various other high school activities. All members are in at least one other choral group.

Today the group is comprised of 40 singers/dancers. An accompanying band (formerly known as Storm Crows) will be auditioning in November. An all important (and hard-working) group of technical crew members will also be formed to accompany the SHOW CARDS to their performances and competitions.

The SHOW CARDS travel throughout the region for performance and competition opportunities. Last year the SHOW CARDS competed in 5 competitions. These included Fairfield, North Central, Teays Valley, Edgewood and Wapakoneta high schools. They receive yearly invitations to the top show choir competitions throughout the nation. They were the 1<sup>st</sup> place trophy winners of the 1999 North American Music Festival in Toronto, Ontario. The renowned Brent "Woody" Holland is the choreographer. SHOW CARDS arrangements are by Eric VanCleave. The director of the SHOW CARD band is Susan Budd. The SHOW CARDS are under the direction of the Music Department Head, Joseph M. Budd.

Unfortunately, at the time of this writing we do not have a schedule of upcoming event. The SHOW CARDS are planning to perform at CHS' fall and spring concerts, along with the choral holiday show in December. There is a 2-1/2

day retreat scheduled in early December where they will meet with their choreographer. Here they will concentrate on learning their songs and dances for the competition show which they will perform regionally/nationally several times January through May, 2002.

This is an enthusiastic group of high school students. One of the main goals of this group is to promote the importance of choral music in our public schools and to share their many talents with the school district and community. We wish them much success in the coming year as they proudly represent our alma mater.

Two former Colerain Students were selected as Distinguished Graduates. The first was Sherry Weisman Parr Class of 1970. While attending Colerain Sherry was a Rhythmette, member of Future Teachers of America, and C - Club. After graduation she received a Bachelors in Education from Eastern Kentucky in 1974 and later a Masters Degree in Education from Xavier. She started her education career by teaching at both Mt. Healthy and Liberty Junior Highs. In 1988 she was selected to be Assistant Principal at Freedom Elementary in the Lakota School System. Sherry became principal of Reading Central Elementary in 1992. During her seven-year tenure as principal, Reading Central won the Blue Ribbon Award for Quality Education from the United States Department of Education. Sherry was chosen as 1998 Elementary Principal of the Year in the State of Ohio. For the past two years Sherry has been the Superintendent for Reading Community Schools. Sherry is married to her husband Mick and has two children.

Our next distinguished graduate was Mike Remias Class of 1972. While at Colerain Mike was Captain of the 1972 football team and also lettered in track and baseball. He was also a member of National Honor Society. After graduation Mike was appointed to the United States Military Academy at West Point. Mike graduated from West Point in 1976 with a degree in Engineering, and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in the Artillery. After several overseas tours Mike was promoted to Captain in 1980. During the 1980's Mike earned his Masters in Operation Research and attended the Army Command School. In 1989 Mike was promoted to the rank of Major. During Operation Desert Storm, Mike was in command of troops that were responsible for preventing the Iraqi Army's retreat to Baghdad. For his efforts Mike was awarded the Bronze Star. After Desert Storm, Mike became a Lieutenant Colonel and was assigned as a Systems Analyst at the Pentagon. His last tour of duty was in research acquisition for the Assistant Secretary of the Army. Mike retired from the military in 1997 and now works as a project manager for Lockheed Martin. Mike has two children and lives in Dallas.

### HISTORY OF CHS

Colerain Centralized Township School opened in September 1924. In the April 26<sup>th</sup>, 1924 Hamilton Journal Newspaper there was an entire page given to the history of the many one and two room schools that had served the area. The following is an article about Dry Ridge. In future editions we hope to also write the histories of Old Round Top Schools. **Editors note: The actual sentences and grammar are exactly as it appeared in the Hamilton Journal of April 26<sup>th</sup>.**

The X in the picture indicates the location of Dry Ridge School. In the valley two miles distant can be seen the little village of New Baltimore, and adjacent to the school grounds one of the big hills. It is very easy to get a picture of a one room school, but very hard to find such artistic surroundings. Dry Ridge was District 12 in Colerain Township. It was a one-room building situated high above the Miami Valley on a large level tract of land. The largest and most level of any steelyard of Colerain Township. The view of the surrounding hills and the Miami Valley to the west one half mile distant is a scene of grandeur. People passing through stop and gaze spellbound on the beauties of scenery of the Dry Ridge hills and the valley below. There were a large number of graceful willow trees on the school grounds and every spring the older boys would make willow whistles for the children and then sit in the shade and play mumbletypeg. This may not be a familiar game today but it was played with jack knives and required great skill. This school was surrounded on two sides by the Eli Scull Farm, now the property of John Craig who bought the school building and grounds. Mr. Craig has torn the building down recently. School has not been held here for twelve years. Spelling matches and magic lantern shows furnished many social gatherings, along with the regular entertainments given by the school at Christmas and other big days with usually a picnic on the last day of school. The last five teachers were James Radcliffe, Charles Happ, who taught at Dry Ridge for nine years and here Mr. Happ married a former pupil, Carolyn Weik. He was succeeded by George Lloyd Laird who married another daughter of the Weik home, Miss Melezene Weik. Mr. Laird later resigned to take up law. It is not strange that romance should have had some brilliant scenes up in that poetic country and these two love stories alone have made happy school memories for two

pupils and two teachers. After Mr. Laird came, Virgil Keeling and then A. C. Hoock who was the last teacher. Waldo Weik, a pupil of this school, enlisted at the beginning of the World War and served overseas in the medical corp. He returned and is now living in Huntington, West Virginia. Charles Monteville Flowers has honored his old school as a prominent educator and lecturer. His home is in Los Angeles, California, but two years ago on a lecture tour spoke in Cincinnati. Many of his former schoolmates were fortunate to hear him speak. George Benzing, Charles Benzing, Samuel Benzing, Waldo H. Weik became teachers. Clarence Raish of Dayton, Ohio, and George Weik of Haywood, Nebraska, are ministers.

Dear *Chatter* Editor and all Old Timers: Many moons ago, I attended Colerain School in the old 3 story building on Springdale Road. I use to go to school with my mother when she would volunteer in the school cafeteria. Mom would sit me out in the hall on a first grade chair and I would entertain the kids as they would come through the cafeteria line. I use to love to sing "Sweet Jenny Lee". I can't remember the words

ow, but I knew the whole song. I started to 1st grade and went thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade with all the same classmates. Some were Thelma Nippert, Ruth Zoellner, Jean Laib, Eugene Minges, Helen Herman, Ed Seibert, John Raisch, and Red Thei. I then moved to Venice in 1940 and attended Ross School in their original building which was also 3 stories. I graduated from Ross High in 1944. I always loved school at Colerain and later at Ross. I had lots of ties to my former classmates and teachers as well at both schools. Some of my teachers were Ms. Jackson, Ms Potts, Mrs. Craig, Ms. Zimmerman, Mr. Purdy and Mr. Arnold, who died of cancer when we were in 6<sup>th</sup> grade. I remember he was laid out at his home and all the school busses went down on River Road to his viewing. It was a hard year for me as I loved Mr. Arnold.
