Two former Colerain students were selected as Distinguished Graduates. The first was **Steve Scovic '62**. Steve played basketball and baseball while attending Colerain High School. He graduated from the University of Dayton in 1966 with a BS in Chemistry and Biology. Steve received his Masters in Counseling from Dayton in 1968 and his Doctorate in Counseling from UC in 1975. Steve started his education career as a teacher and later as Assistant Principal at Northridge High School in Dayton. He became Principal of Vandalia Butler High School in 1975. He later served as Superintendent at Bethal Local, Fairborn City and Kettering Schools in Dayton. Steve has published numerous educational articles and has received many awards. He retired from education in 1998 and now lives in Kiawah Island South Carolina with his wife Carol.

Mary Seibert was a very good student while I was a teacher at CHS. I enjoyed reading this issue of the Chatter. It brought back many memories of my teaching days at CHS. My first class was seventh graders in the basement of what is now the elementary building. Charles Eger, brother of John Eger and Clarence Brestel were in the class. Other members were Alma Bender Prussinger, Della Jane Hill, Dale Diefenberger, Robert Young and Bob Muehlenhard. Emerson Hoock whose father was on the school board. Mr. Harry Taylor taught Social Studies and coached girls' basketball. Clarence Struble taught Spanish, coached boys' basketball and served as school principal. We started football as me as coach on a field that had been part of Langhorst farm. We called it the corn bowl. After nine years at CHS, I went to Deer Park and started football as a high school sport. I have been elected to both CHS and Deer Park Hall of Fame. I have lost two wives and my left arm to cancer. Dear Alumni: How different this year's 1934-class reunion seemed. While our graduating class consisted of 20 people and 10 are still living, only 5 were able to attend this year's class reunion. Katherine Brock (now Marie Westberg) a Florida resident shared with us some notes her fifth grade autobiography and class notebook (just imagine 1926 – 77 years ago). For some strange reason, which she can't explain or won't explain, she only kept records on the girls. All the men thought this was a good decision on her part. There were nineteen girls plus a number of boys in that fifth grade class, which was taught by Miss Sedler. Only seven of these girls stayed the course until 1934 but we did add another five girls to make the total of twelve girls and eight boys graduating in 1944. This makes a 60 to 40 percent ratio. To the readers of the CHS Chatter: A luncheon was held June 19, 2003, at Dante's Restaurant celebrating the 67th year of our graduation from CHS. This was the first class to begin school in what was then known as the Colerain Township Centralized School District. In September of 1924 this was the only school located at Poole and Sprindale Roads. At that time there were no inside toilets, used a cistern and well water, there was no cafeteria and peoples had to bring their own books which we had to do for twelve years. This was also the first class to start in the first class and to graduate from high school. The graduating class of 1936 totaled 26, which was the largest up to that time. There are currently ten living and sixteen deceased. Those attending the luncheon that began in the first grade and completed their twelve grades were Alberta Bernhardt Corboy, Alma Bender Pussenger, Raymond Brestel, Charles Eger, Norman Muehlenhard and Ed Moeller. Other graduates attending were Ray Walters, Mary Harmeyer Wullenweber, and Doris Thiemann Lepker.
