One week later, tests showed that Jim was seriously ill. Jim was able to work until mid-April when he entered University Hospital for the first of three rounds of chemo. Jim investigated a bone marrow transplant and clinical trials, but could not participate in either program. I saved my vacation to take care of Jim and learned how to give him his chemo shots and flush his port. But the cancer became stronger and the chemo no longer kept it under control. Jim died at home with a dear friend and family at his side. His last words were "I love you so much." Jim could fix anything, including car problems and everything around the house. Two of Jim's favorite projects were a large swing set he helped our son David '87 build for our granddaughters, the light of his life. For Christmas, 2001, he made a wood refrigerator and stove/sink unit for the girls after their Mom saw a set in a catalogue. We did so many things together: antiqueing, refinishing furniture, cooking, gardening, hiking, and biking. We had a great time taking our granddaughter Anna camping and hiking two years ago. What fun we had! Because our granddaughters are so young – 5, 3, and 1 years old – I am asking everyone who knew Jim to send stories you remember of him (pictures would be nice, too) for a memory book for the girls. 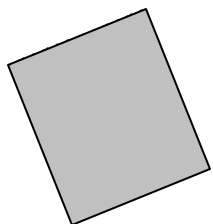
