
EXCELLENT!



COLERAIN TRACK


On April 12, 2006, the 37th Annual Vince Mercure Track & Field Invitational will be held. The late Vince Mercure was a World War II veteran and a long-time track coach at Colerain High School. He taught Social Studies from 1952-1969 and also coached the football team to its first league championship in 1967. The Colerain Invitational named for him began in 1970 and is the longest running invitational in the city. Other people who were honored were Ken Meibers, Mason Ward, Angie Kist '98, and Frank Russo '79.

- Ken Meibers coached track and field at Colerain and Princeton High Schools for 32 years, claiming 42 league championships, 32 district titles, 11 regional championships, and 12 state championships (6 individual, 6 relay). He coached the 1978 Colerain Boys' Cross Country team that won the Division I State Championship. The meet's 4 x 100 Meter Relay is named for Coach Meibers.

- Mason Ward, a 2000 graduate of Colerain High School's is Colerain's most decorated runner. He was a two-time state champion in the 1600 Meter Run (1999 and 2000), and was the 1600 Meter Champion at the Penn Relays in 2000. In 2000, he was the Bronze Medallist in the 1600 Meter Run at the Millrose Games and placed fourth in the prestigious Golden West Invitational with a time of 4:07.00. The meet's 1600 Meter Run is named for Mason.

- Angie Kist, a 1998 graduate of Colerain High School, was a seven-time state qualifier in track and cross-country. She was a member of Colerain's fist Girls' Cross Country state championship team in 1997 and earned All-State Honors in the 800 Meter Run and the 4 x 800 Meter Relay as well. She went on to an illustrious career at the University of Cincinnati, earning All-Conference honors in track and cross-country. As a senior, she won the 1500 Meter Run at the 2002 Conference USA indoor meet with a time of 4:50.01. The meet's 800 Meter Run is named for Angie.

- Frank Russo, a 1979 graduate of Colerain High School, led the Colerain Boys' Cross Country team to the 1978 Division I State Championship. He was Colerain's number one cross-country runner during his three years, and was a four-time state qualifier between track and cross-country. He was later named a cross-country captain at Ohio State, where he also lettered in track. Frank has enjoyed a distinguished coaching career at LaSalle High School, where he has won state championships in track and field (1996) and cross country (2005). The meet's 3200 Meter Run is named for Frank.



The Boosters have completed another successful year and wish to thank all of the volunteers and contributors who provided support above and beyond the call of duty. Since its founding in 1948, the Boosters have worked to meet the needs of **all** students involved in extracurricular activities. There is a strong sense of community associated with Colerain High School and this is evident by the number of alumni who remain in the area and choose to send their children to Colerain. Contributions have come from over 25 states ranging from Washington to Florida and points in between. **No taxpayer dollars** have been spent in support of this project!

One only needs to drive by the stadium on any given day to see the benefits that the field provides for our students and the community as a whole. Since its installation, the field has been used regularly for Physical Education classes, marching band competitions, youth football games, cornhole tournaments, lacrosse tournaments, middle school football games, soccer, baseball, and softball practices in addition to Varsity, Junior Varsity, and Freshman Football games.

The Boosters also continue to support the Band, Orchestra, Show Cards, Student Council, Drama Club, Colerain and White Oak Middle Schools, over 20 sports at the high school and provide annual scholarships. Support of these groups and activities is accomplished through funds generated from a number of Booster events such as the annual Craft Show, Antique Show, Monte Carlo, Golf Outing, and Stag.
