Kerry Dugan - A a 1987 graduate of CHS and presently teaches English and coaches Girls Golf at Colerain High School. She recently sent this letter to the Alumni Association. We found it very inspiring.

CAN YOU REALLY GO HOME?

I think the answer is yes. Twenty-one years ago I graduated from Colerain High School. I had spent my entire compulsory educational experience in the Northwest Local School District. Some people would say I was sheltered, but I would say I was blessed.

Upon graduation, I wasn't quite sure what I wanted to do with my life. I worked for awhile, then decided college might be for me. Even though I didn't have a major, I found that NWLSD had prepared me exceptionally well for the college experience. I remember discussing some of the required reading lists with my peers, and realizing that I was the only one who had already read many of the titles. Somehow my teachers had provided with me an advantage over my peers, including those from the "better" and the "private" schools.

When I decided to become a teacher (well, when teaching found me), I didn't even apply at any other schools. How could I possibly teach anywhere else? I felt like I owed something to the school that gave me so much. Maybe I could be the teacher that prepared Colerain kids for life and college, just like my teachers prepared me. What an honor it would be to be compared to someone like Ms. Sprunger, Ms. McDowell, Mr. Stockland, Mr. Nevel, or Mr. Kocica! There are far too many great teachers at CHS to name them all, but those and many like them, pushed me to be better than I was, and encouraged me to believe in my own potential.

When people realize I teach at my alma mater they often ask, "Isn't that weird?" At times, it is strange. But mostly, it is extraordinary. CHS is all it was when I was in school, and yet so much more. Do you realize we have an excellent rating at a time when most public schools keep sliding down the rungs of the state report card? We offer so many classes and extra-curricular activities that no one even thought about when I was a student. We have a diverse population that represents what this country is all about: a place for everyone. If a student wants to be involved, the sky is the limit.

I'm no Pollyanna - there are days that are challenging. But I work in a school where we are a team; where I know I can count on my peers to strive to make CHS a better school - even though we are already excellent - and where I can rely on students to be inquisitive toward learning and trustworthy in their daily decisions. When I walked out of the front door of CHS in June of 1987, full of teen angst and full of myself, I said to my friends, "I won't be back." But every morning as I pull in the driveway for another school day, I smile to myself and think ironically how good it is, indeed, to be back!




