

ROBOTICS

• The students of the Engineering Tech Prep program competed in the FIRST Robotics Competition. The team is comprised of junior and senior students who work collaboratively with adult mentors to design, build and program a mobile robot that competes in an annual game challenge. This year, the game challenge was 3-on-3 basketball, called "Rebound Rumble." The team competed regionally in Cincinnati and Cleveland and also at the World Championship Event in St Louis, Mo. During three weeks of the competition season, our team hosted a team of outstanding students from Brazil, South America. It was a privilege to host them and work with them. They lived with us, attended class with our students, competed against us and both teams had a tremendous experience.

Our team was also very proud to have one student recognized through a prestigious award. Mr Ray Frank, a senior in the Butler Tech Engineering Tech Prep Class at Colerain HS, was awarded the Dean's List Finalist Award at the Queen City Regional FIRST Robotics contest. This award celebrates a student's outstanding leadership and effectiveness in advancing respect and appreciation for engineering and engineers, both within their school, as well as their community. FIRST Dean's List Finalists will compete at the championship for the FIRST Dean's List. To appreciate the scale of this award, there are nearly 20,000 students participating in the FIRST Robotics Competition world-wide. At each of the 52 regional events, only 2 students are selected for this honor. Ray Frank is now one of 104 students to compete at the World Championship event next week in St Louis, Missouri where only 10 students will earn the Dean's List Award. Ray has already been contacted by several prestigious colleges including Yale, M.I.T. and WPI regarding potential enrollment next year. We are very proud of this accomplishment and recognition of his hard work and dedication.

We'd like to extend special recognition to one alumni, Mitch Revetta, who dedicated many hours of help to our current students as a team mentor.

• Congratulations to the Varsity Winter Guard and Winter Percussion won 1st or 2nd at our local events all year and were invited to perform at Winter Guard International (WGI) Championship Finals. For the Winter Guard, they competed on Thursday night April 12, we competed against 106 other guards from across the world at the Cintas Center. They took the top 40 to Semi Finals and we ended up 27th in the world. We then competed Friday at the Nutter Center at Wright State. This is the first time in the history of the program that this has happened. The Varsity Winter Percussion competed on Thursday April 19th and ended up 21st in the world.
