Two former Colerain students were selected as Distinguished Graduates. The first was Andrea Ruehrwein Raynor '79. While at Colerain High Andrea was President of the sophomore, junior, and senior Classes. She was a cheerleader for three years, was active in Honor Society, C-Club and other student activities. She was the 1978 Homecoming Queen and also ran track and was a member of the gymnastics' team. After graduation she attended Dennison University and graduated from Dennison in 1983 with a BA in Religion. During her summers Andrea worked with the homeless in New York City and Boston. She received her Masters of Divinity degree in 1986 from Harvard and became an ordained Methodist minister in 1987. From 1997 to the present Andrea has served as a Hospice Chaplain in the New York City area. During the aftermath of the twin towers bombing, Andrea volunteered to work at Ground

Zero. Her job there was to give comfort to the clean up workers and to give blessing's to the remains of the victims as they were recovered. Our next distinguished graduate was Jeff Phegley '83. Jeff was active in several community organizations while he attended Colerain. He was active in the American Red Cross and was a volunteer at Providence Hospital. Jef also was active in the Cadet program for future policeman. After graduation Jeff secured a job with the Republican National Committee. One of his first assignments was working on the second Reagan Bush Inaugural Ball which Jeff and his parents attended in January 1985. He then worked as an intern for Congressman Michael Oxley, before returning to Cincinnati in late 1985. He briefly attended UC and later graduated from the Police Academy. He secured a job with the Morrow Ohio Police Department. While making a routine traffic stop on January 21st 1987 Jeff was shot and killed in the line of duty.

## 1994 FOOTBALL TEAM HONORED

Colerain's football teams since 1994 have won 88 games and lost 12 regular season games. They have made seven playoff appearances. Their record in post season play is eighteen wins and six losses. They have won seven league championships, and have made three appearances in the final four of the state. They have been regional champs and regional runner-up three times. Here is a true story you may use in your newsletter if you deem it worthy. In June 1938, at age 9 1/2, I attended a Reds game at Crosley Field. It was knothole day so my admission was free. My dad decided he wanted to see Johnny Vander Meer pitch, so he took my brother and me and a classmate

of mine, Melvin "Red" Herrmann. "Red" was a carrot-topped farm boy who had never been to a Reds game, but he had obtained a knothole card and asked to go with us.

The Reds were playing Boston, who, I recall, had changed their nickname from the Braves to the Bees that year. All the knotholers were seated in one designated section. As the game progressed, and "Vandy" mowed down the hitters, the usual knothole chant of "We want a hit, we want a hit" when the Reds were at bat, was changed to "We want an out, we want an out" when Boston was up. The knotholers followed the "Jinx theory" and no one said anything about a possible no-hitter. "Red" asked again and I said it's a no hitter!. He says "What do you mean?" I said Vandy had pitched a no-hitter, Boston had not made any hits "Red" wasn't impressed, he just said "Boy, they must be a lousy team."

I think it was later that summer that the Herrmann's moved to somewhere in Indiana and I never saw "Red" again. I've always wondered if he ever saw another Reds game. The Herrmann's Colerain farm was on Cheviot Road, and I had visited there a time or two. I might be wrong but I believe their house and barn were just about on the exact spot where the current Colerain High School buildings stand.

After a few years, I rarely told anyone that I had seen "Vandy's" first no-hitter. When I did, to many people rolled their eyes or replied "Sure, you and the other 100,000 who were there."

I live in Atlanta area now. I was reminded of all this the other night when I watched on local TV, as Randy Johnson pitched his "perfect game" against the Atlanta Braves. In the last inning, most of the 23,000 loyal Braves fans were standing and cheering for Randy to finish the game "perfectly". They knew it would be baseball history if he did it, and they could tell everyone they were at Turner Field and saw it happen. As the years roll by, they will hear "Sure, you and the other 500,000 fans who were there".
